

Q2 Gender



Q3 Ethnicity








Q7 Licenses, Credentials, and Certifications-select all that apply





Q10 How would you rate your preparation at CSUF in each of the following areas?

- -Excessive group projects
- -Greater focus on neurobiology
- -More in-depth theories course
- -Improvement of addictions course
- -Training/Course on how to build a private practice and marketing skills
- -More class times/later class times
- -Professor bias against conservative views/certain religions
- -More role plays/application of clinical skills in class
- -Dissatisfaction with adjunct faculty
