
5 - How many semesters (including summer semesters) did it take to complete your






12 - How well did the program help you to become aware of the impact of diversity on the

I know this is already a huge emphasis, but better understandings of diversity/specific pops could be great. People must be open to learning, but w/o exposure, it's hard to expand openness. And i feel like it is so important to have that exposure start before we head into our practicum sites. Plus, students say they are learning and trying to become culturally competent/sensitive, but you'd be surprised how many lie or don't care. Topics for more emphasis: sexuality/spirituality/religion.

I wish that I recieved the social justice and equity training that the new 500 students are recieving. I think the culture class needs to be revampt. Culture is not just race as is the sole focus of this class. I wish we discussed religion and spirituality in ANY of the classes.

This is an amazing program in so many ways. One area for improvement could be incorporating even more learning experiences that highlight cultural diversity and competence. Additionally, a greater emphasis on calling each other in (within the program), being open to feedback from one another, confronting each other gently, having honest AND compassionate conversations with each other around our various identities and experiences, as well as what more we can do as social justice advocates.

I would have loved getting more courses that exposed us to trauma. As a professional I am going to focus a lot on trauma work and I would have loved to see this more in courses.
