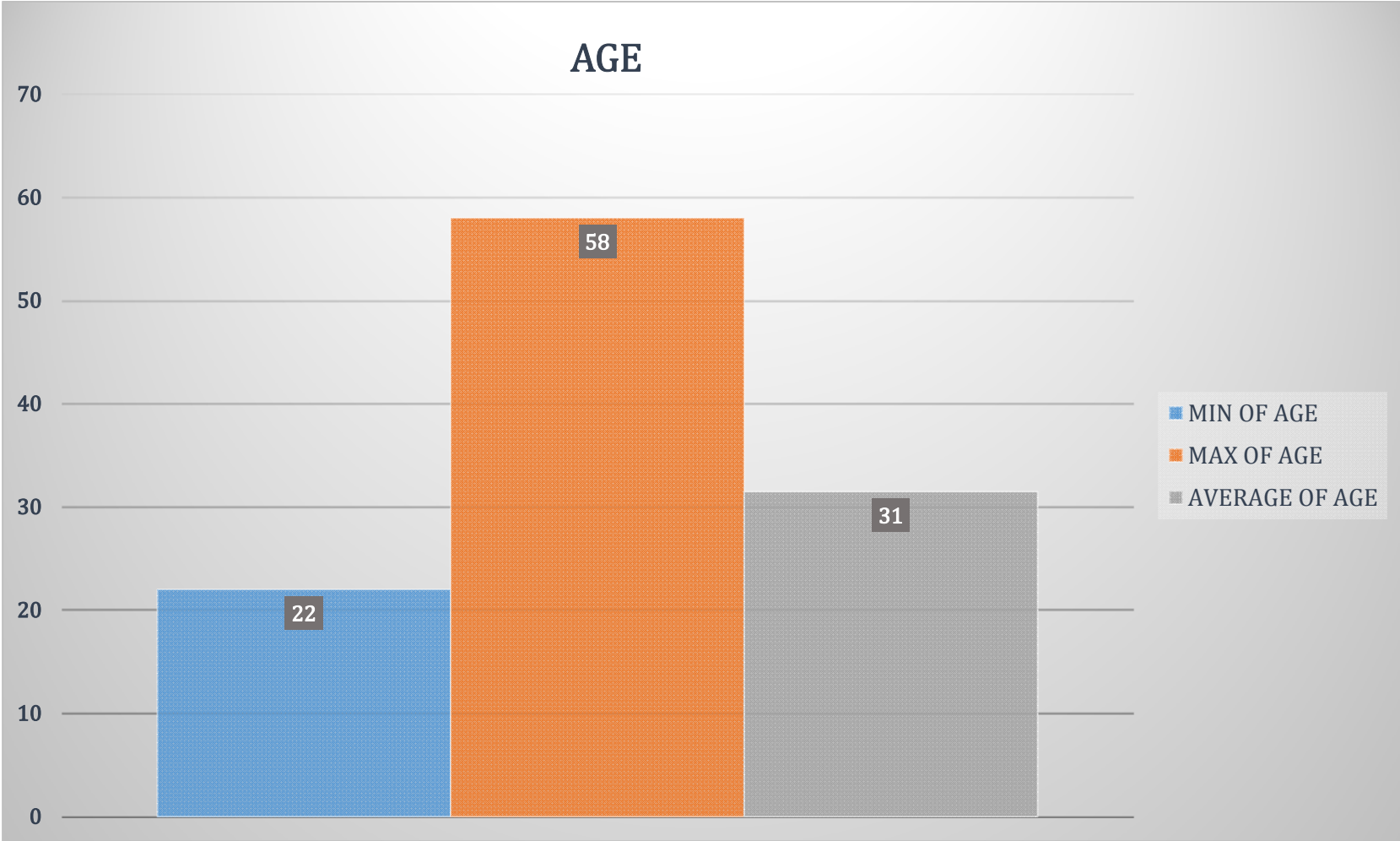

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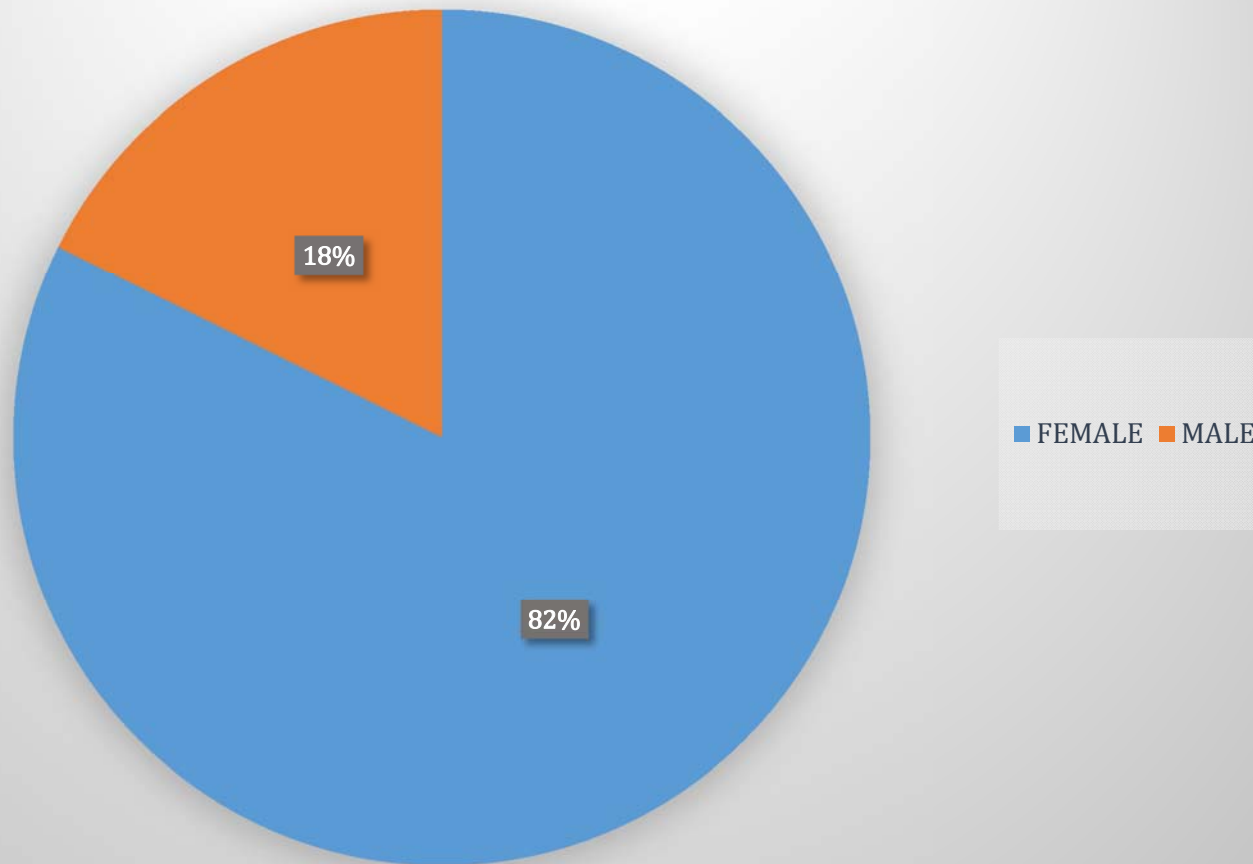

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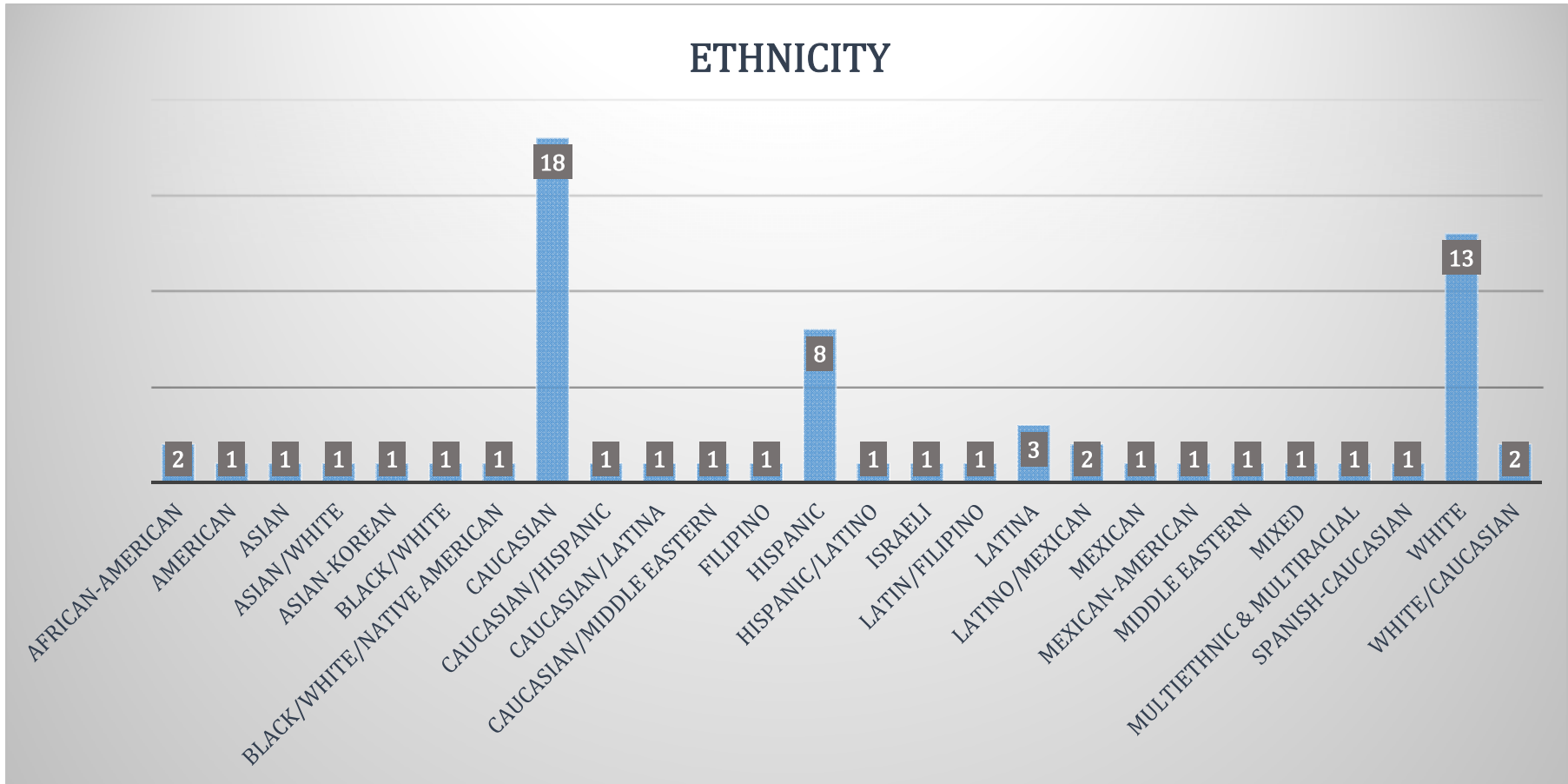
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GENDER

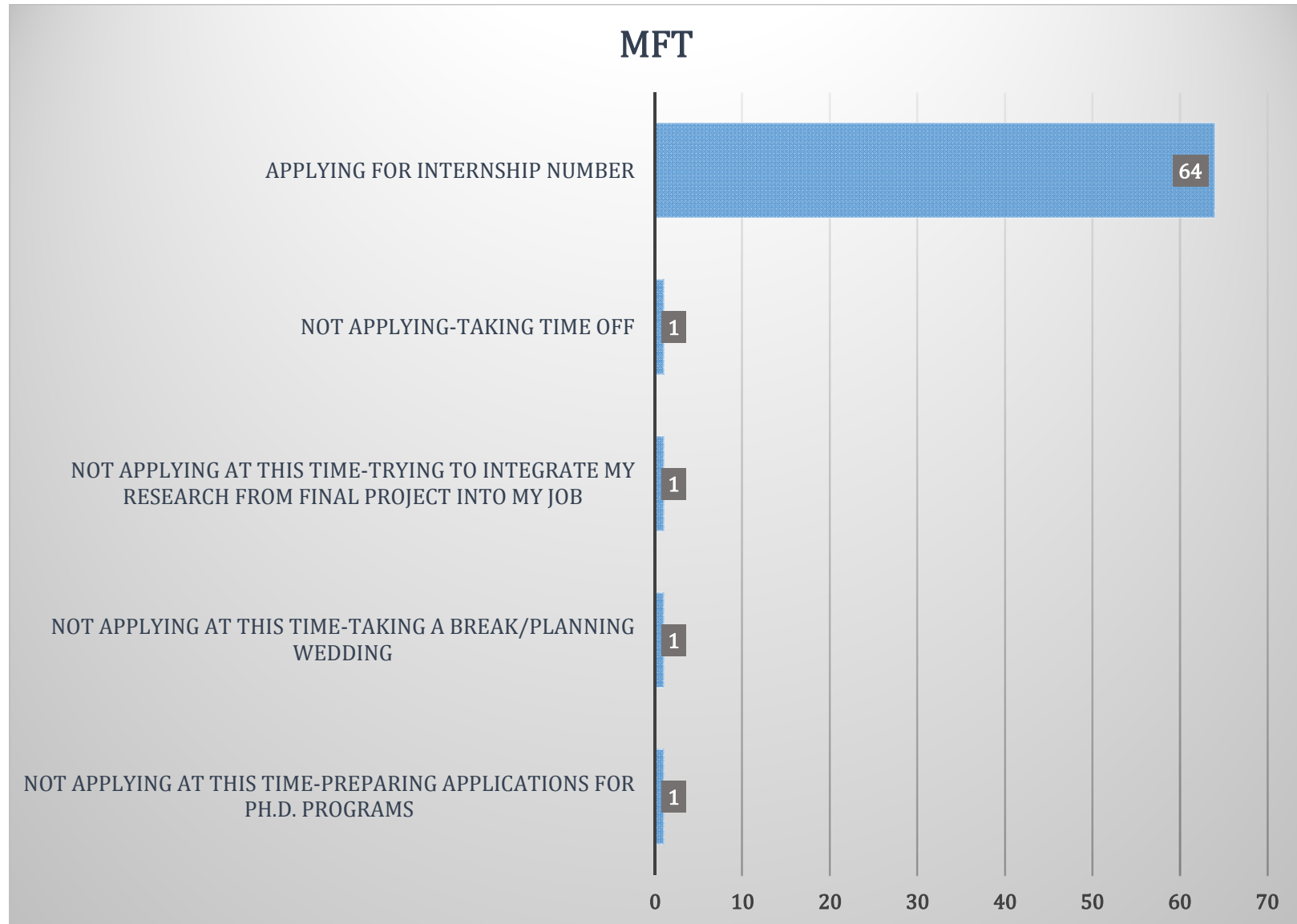

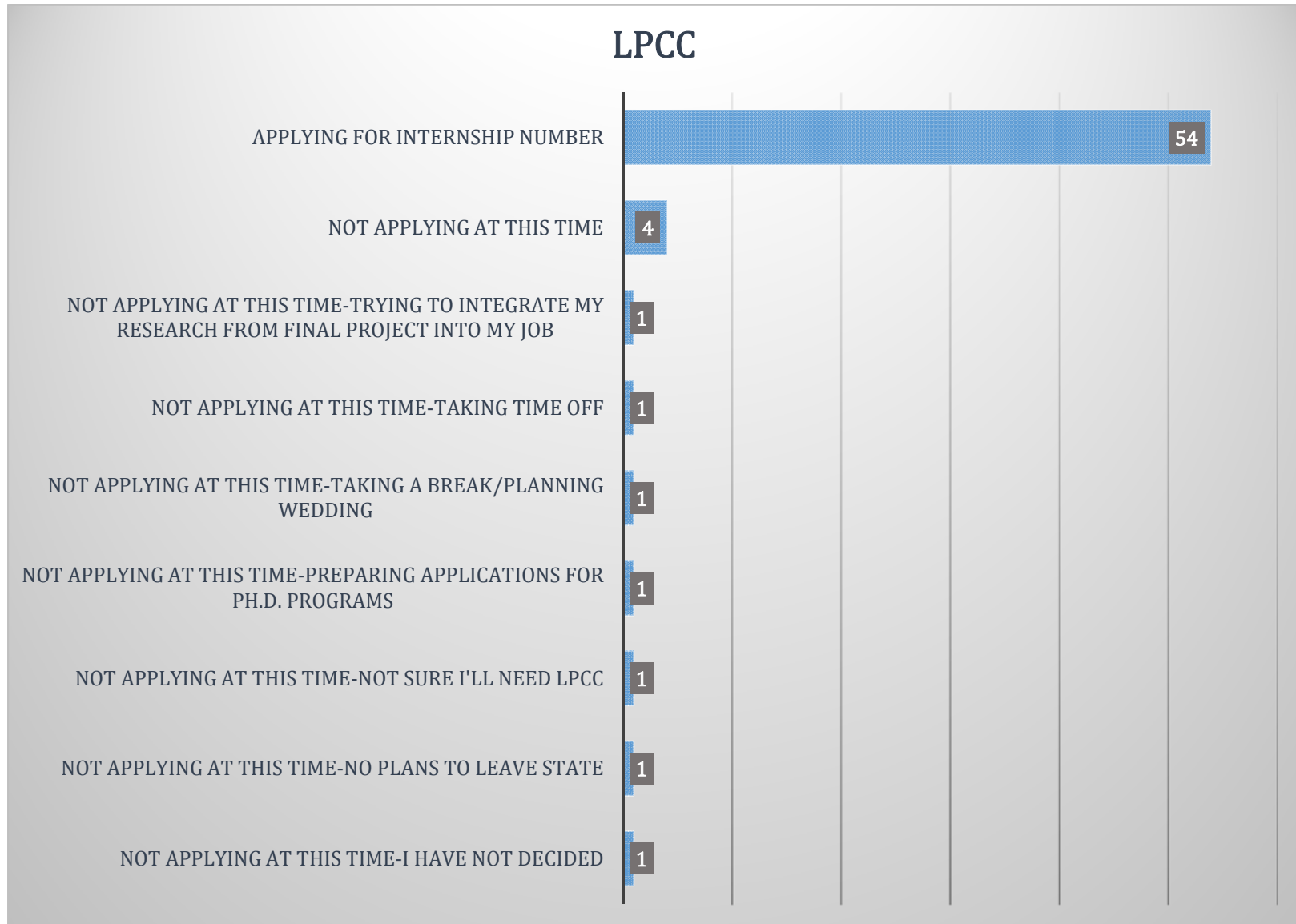
WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS WITH RESPECT TO MFT LICENSING?

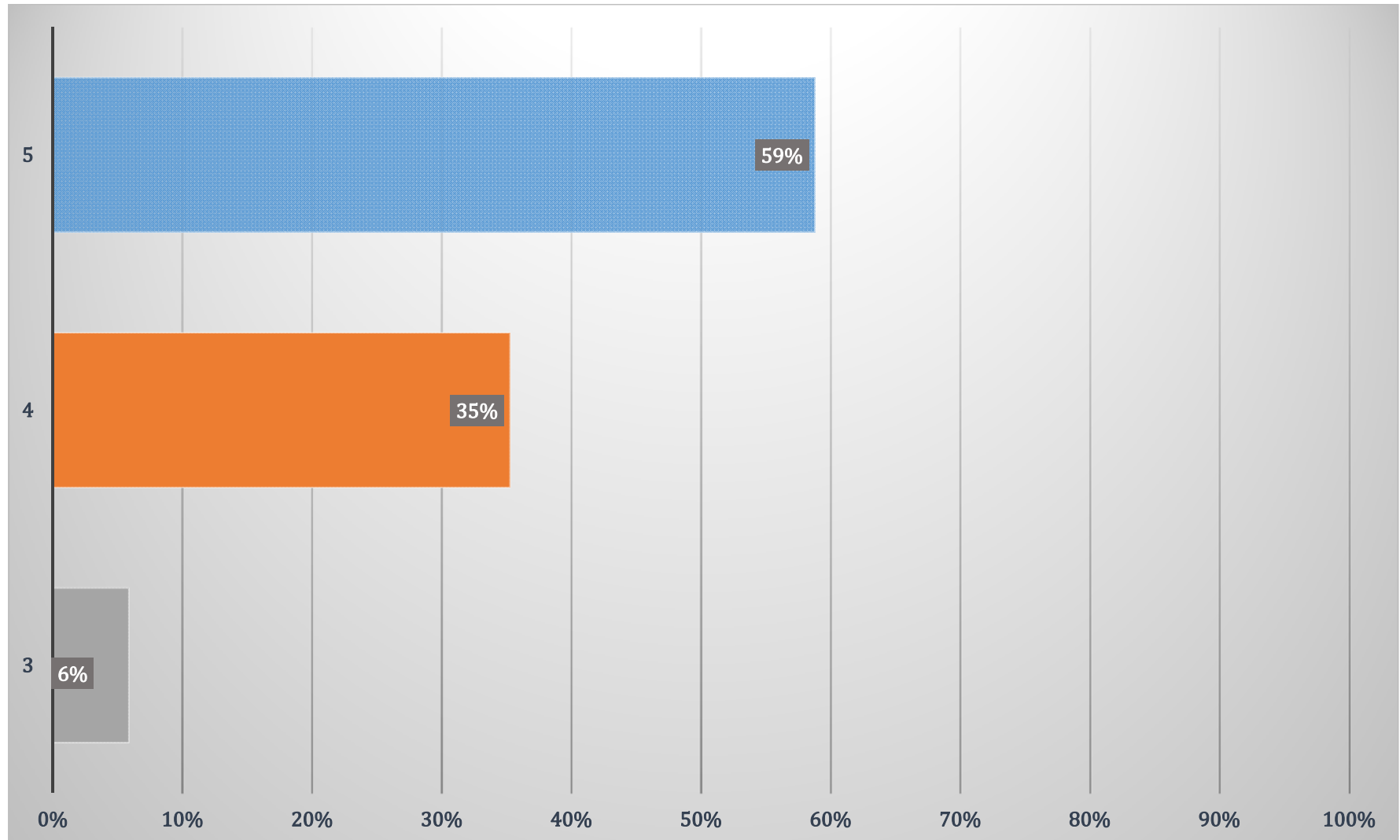

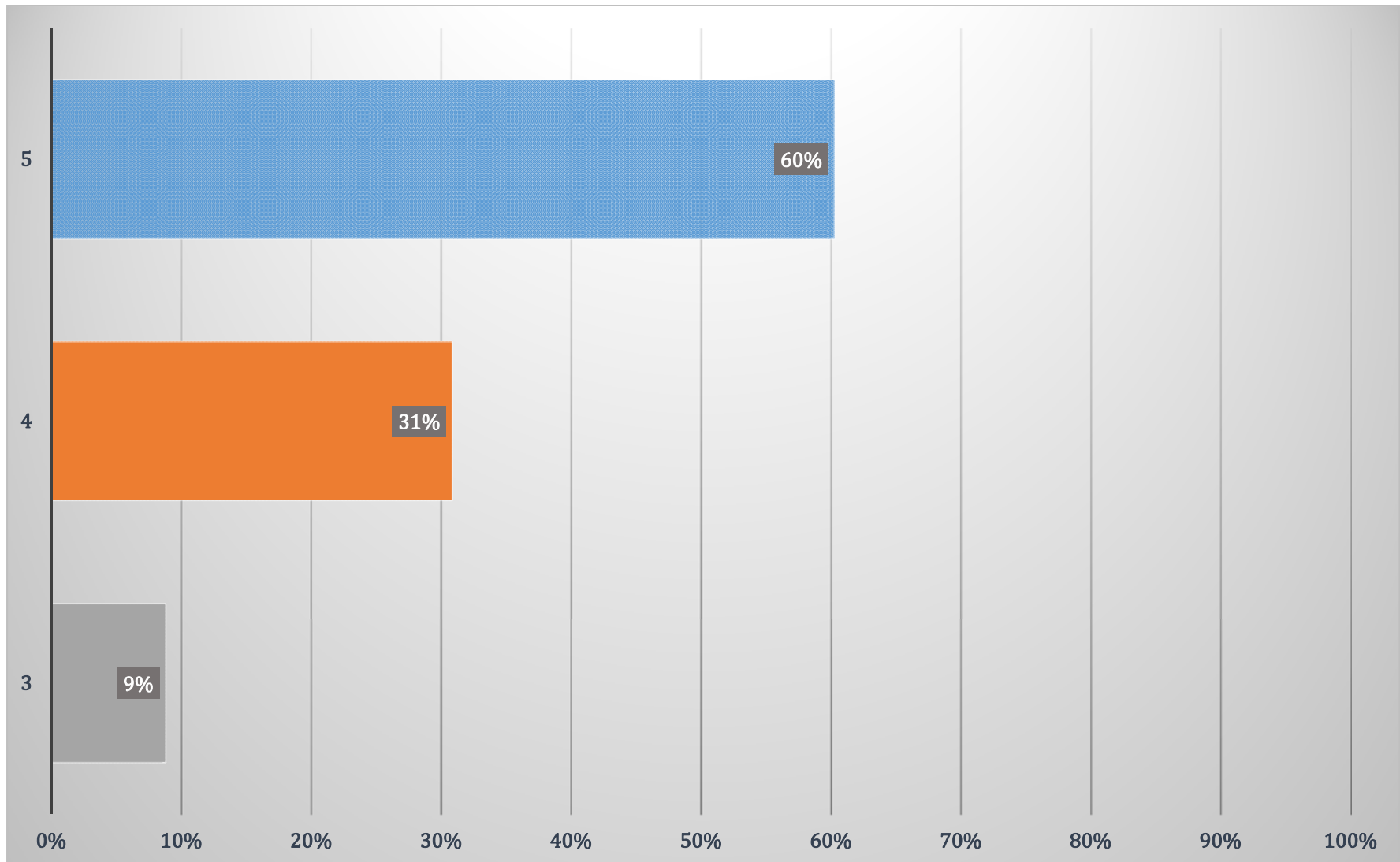

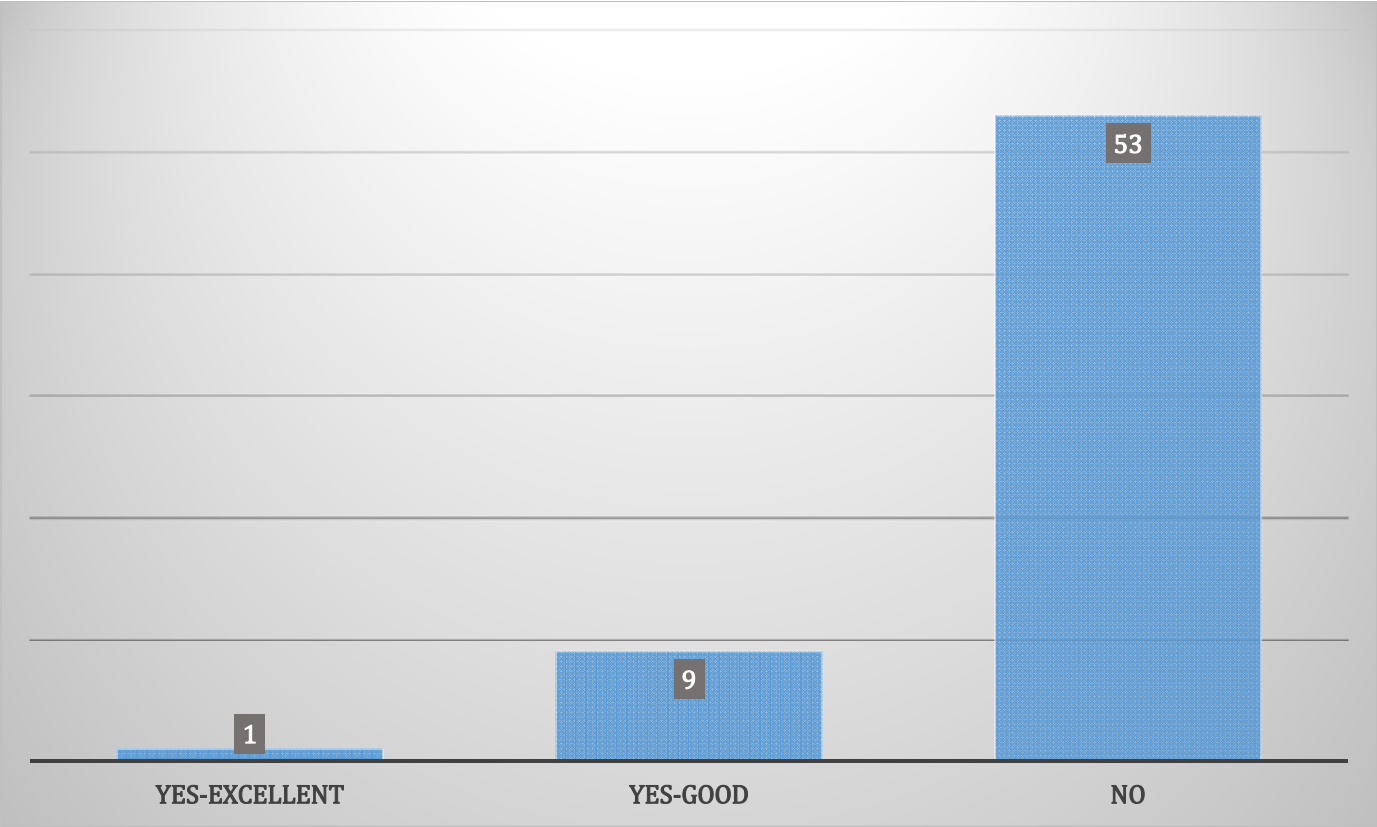

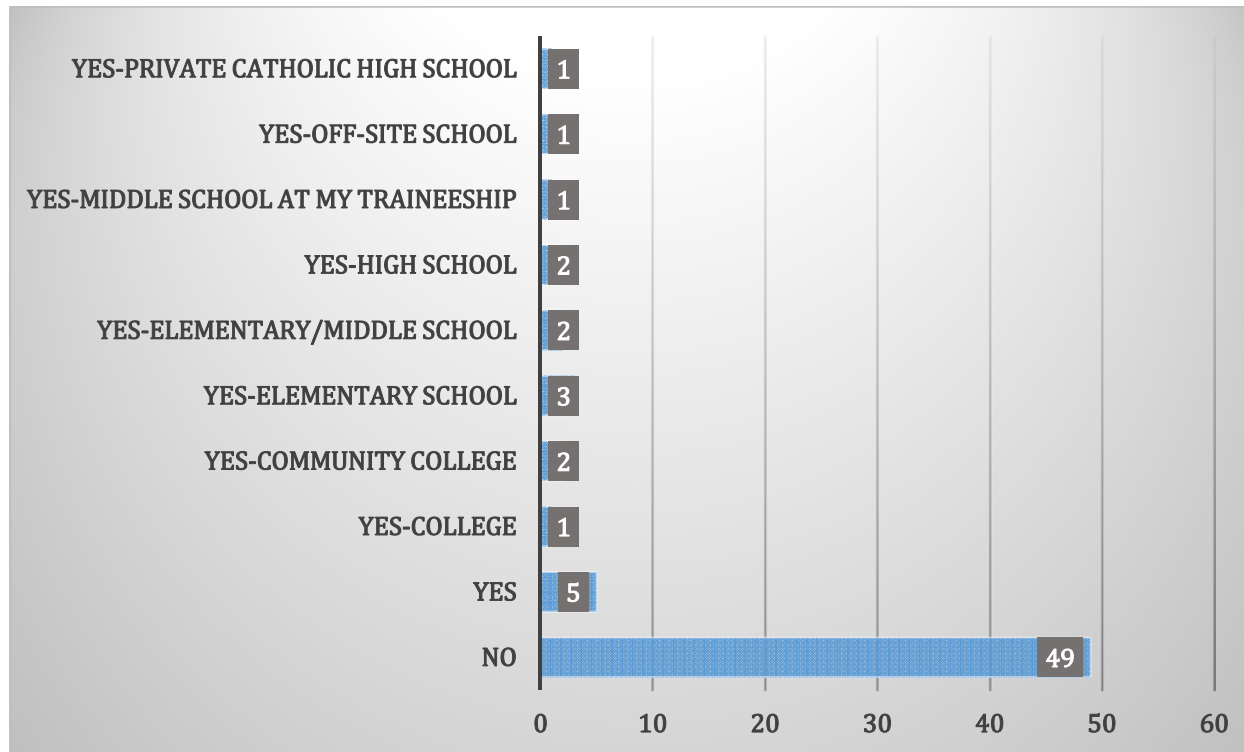

4	A greater exposure to religion, sexual issues, and cultural healing
5	I really would have liked more instruction/courses regarding religion and sexuality. I did not feel that I received enough information in this subject.
6	I think the substance abuse class can be more interactive. Also, it would be a good idea to make one assignment a role play of an assessment/screen for substance abuse. I think it's beneficial for professors to demonstrate motivational interviewing and how to conduct an assessment on substance abuse. One class that I enjoyed & learn the most was child course.
7	*Addictions could have been more interesting/thought provoking if the focus was not on remembering words in the chapter summary for the midterm *More focus on education/training on sex addiction, spirituality & discrimination *Less group work (where students are teaching the content/material) - should be more supplementary
