





Crisis class earlier, ideally prior to practicum or mandatory with first semester of practicum Higher quantity of practice counseling and/or more review of video of therapy sessions (if available) - Studying better "counseling language" i.e. words, common phrases - Similar to group class, higher encouragement of discussing personal experiences - More CSUF outside-of-class involvement to instill more CSUF identity (assignments) I am so proud to have been a part of this program.

A much much much greater focus on practical application of skills. Improve the practicum system. I learned most when with clients, but I and many others found our practicum sites hostile. Support the students, rather than just pretending to. Focus on teaching good useful classes instead of worshiping CACREP's accreditation. Don't advertise the program as two years when its practically ensured to take longer. Stop boasting about how 'good the program is'. I wish I could say more but no one cares.

What it's like working at non-profit and how it may require others to not be humanistic, working more than 40 hours, and how to deal with people not caring about the clients.

I wish there were more information regarding the career options for Therapists other than just direct client services (e.g., book writer, presenter). I also believe there should be more Ánimo classes other than just the 5.

In general, I think having more specific diversity courses would be helpful, including ones that serve the BIPOC, LGBTQ+, and Disability communities. I also thinking starting final project earlier would be beneficial, as it feels rushed at times trying to get it all done in the realm of two semesters.

I would strongly suggest free counseling support mandatory for students of the program—this would be helpful especially for the more personal classes/papers like the family genogram paper and group course

Instead of running the culture class as a way to demean people of certain religions, gender, or other cultural backgrounds, it would have been more helpful to actually learn about those cultures, so I could be better prepared to incorporate religion or masculinity or whatever else into my practice for those clients. More scaffolding techniques like used in DSM, Research, and Project. Fewer professors like who belittle students and more like who support students.

I felt that taking the Crisis/Trauma course as a hybrid option came with benefits, but I also feel that perhaps I would have enjoyed the Crisis/Trauma course in person where more discussion and practice of skills could take place as the subject is highly important for the profession in counseling. Other than that, the program was excellent!

Program has a lack of understanding and care on impact of disability for both students and clients; lack of accountability on being socially justice oriented, doesn't take students concerns seriously.

Stop requiring free labor (truly a dream, I know)
