As you begin your junior year, there are important university requirements that you should complete to graduate on time.



Complete an Upper Division Writing Course

Child & Adolescent Studies: CAS 300

Health Science: English 301

Human Services: Human Services 385

Kinesiology: English 301

Nursing: Nursing 305/305L

File a Grad Check

Each prospective graduate must file for graduation. A student is eligible to apply for graduation after accumulating 85 units. Undergrads must pay the \$115 graduation/diploma fee and file a request for a grad check with the Office of Admissions and Records one year (two semesters) prior to the date on which they anticipate completing all requirements for a degree.

You can apply for your grad check on line if you meet the minimum application requirements. You are not required to pay the \$115 graduation fee at the time of application for graduation. For more information, go to <http://www.fullerton.edu/admissions/CurrentStudent/>

Financial Aid Exit Interviews

All students receiving funds under the Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) Programs (Stafford Loans) or Federal Perkins loan programs are required by law to attend an exit interview prior to graduation, total withdrawal from classes, transferring to another school or dropping below six units. It is the responsibility of every Federal Perkins Loan recipient to contact the Student Loans and University Collections Office at (657) 278-2952 and schedule this exit interview before leaving campus. FFEL borrowers will be emailed an exit interview schedule at the end of their last semester. Failure to complete an exit interview will result in a hold placed on your university records.
