Graduation procedures:

- Apply for graduation once you have completed 85 units or more
 - You will receive an invitation to apply via your to-do list on your CSUF web portal

- Once you have applied
 - Pay your graduation fee at the cashier's window (UH-180)
 - You will receive an invitation to attend a Live Grad Check via email
