- ** Students planning on pursuing a credential or post-graduate studies should see an appropriate advisor.
- ** Students planning on pursuing a special education credential must take SPED 322, SPED 425, and an approved ethnic studies course.
- ** Students planning on pursuing an elementary education credential must take EDEL 315, EDEL 325, and an approved ethnic studies course.
- ** At least three of the six concentration-specific courses from Topical Developmental Courses must be upper division
- ** To satisfy the Basic Skills requirement for education credentials (CBEST), earn a B- or better in GE A.2, A.3, and B.4. For more information, visit the Center for Careers in Teaching (ed.fullerton.edu/cct).
