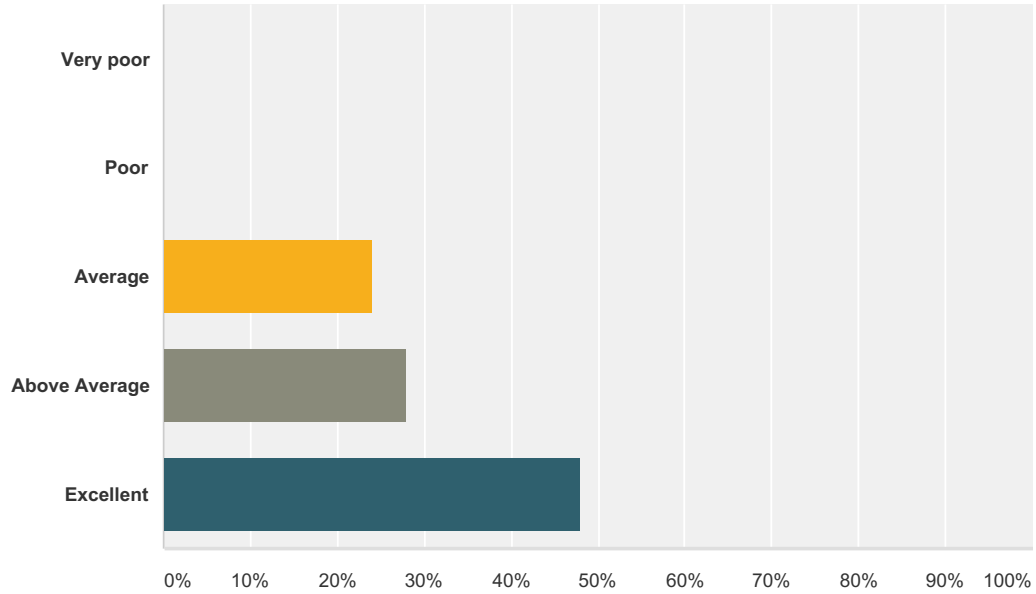


Q1 Compared to other masters degree counseling students that you have hired, CSUF students' overall educational preparation is:

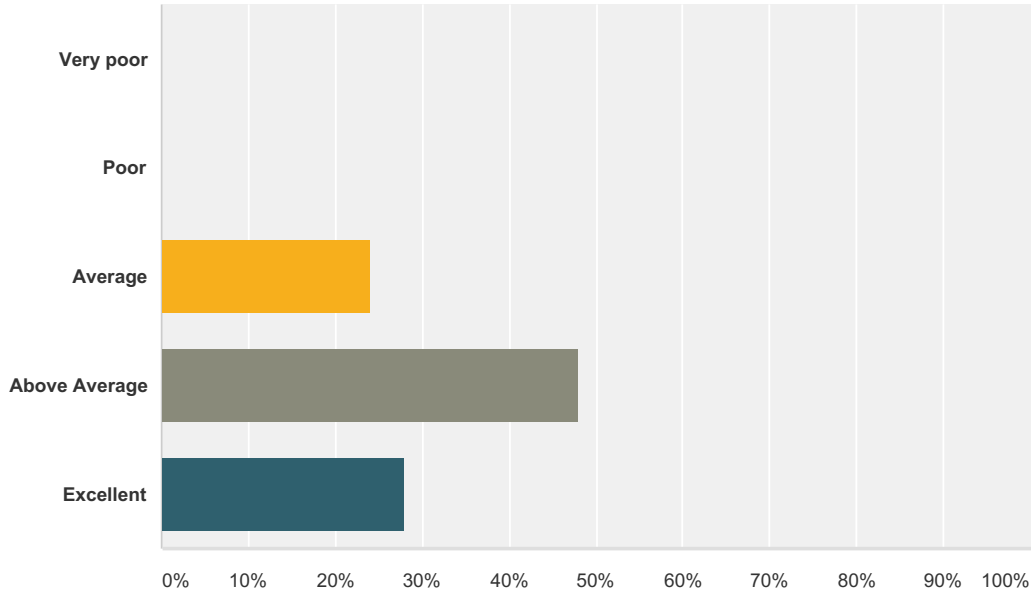

Q2 Compared to other masters degree counseling students that you have hired, CSUF students' ability to demonstrate effective counseling skills with clients are:

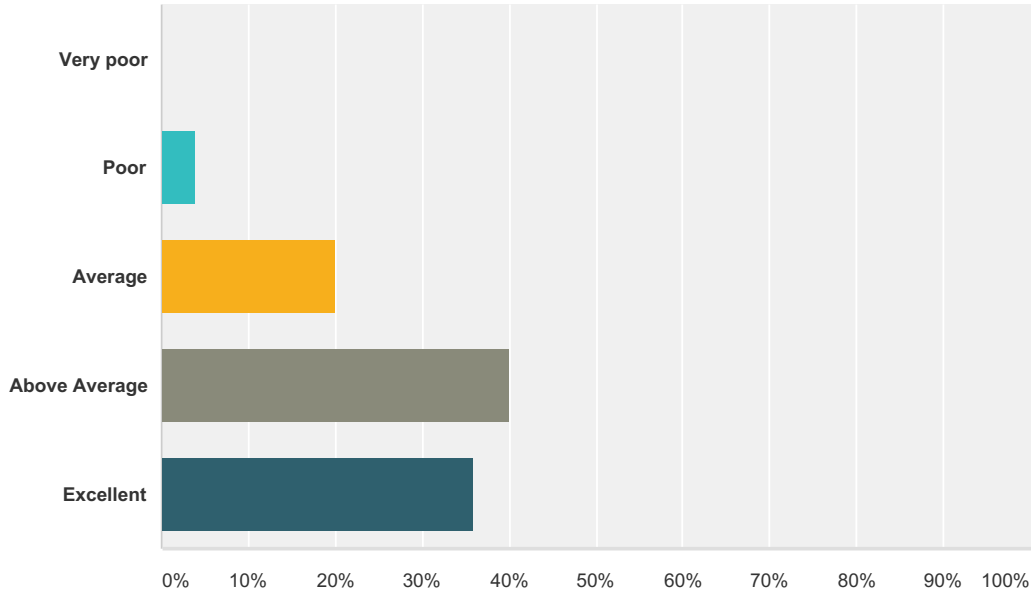

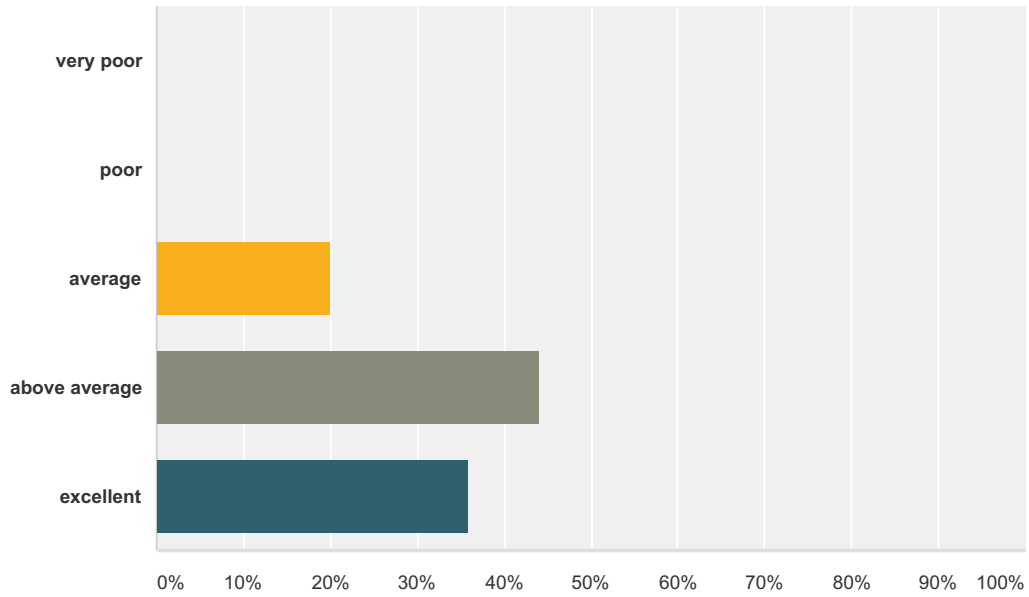

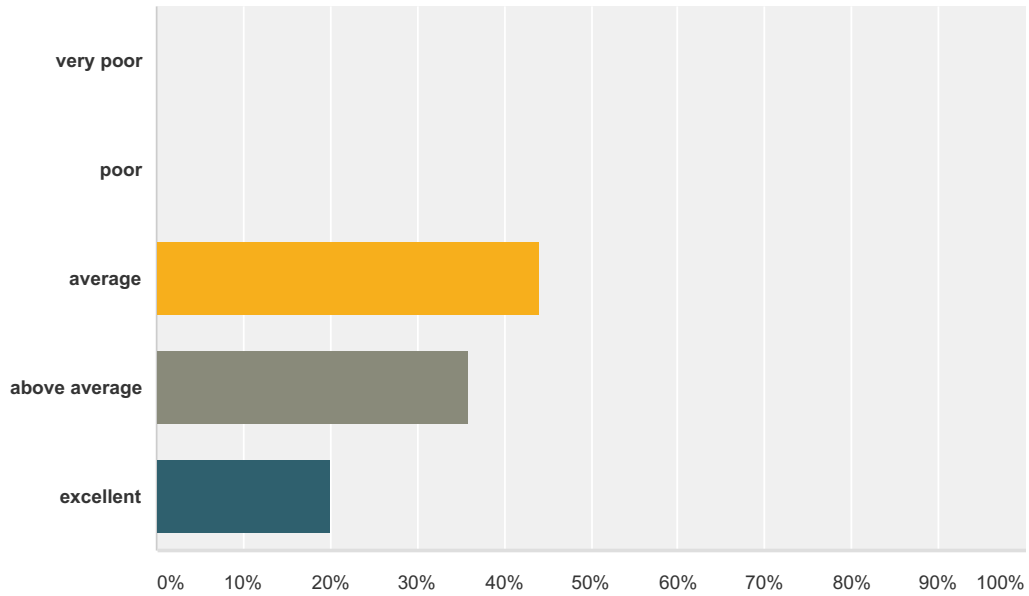

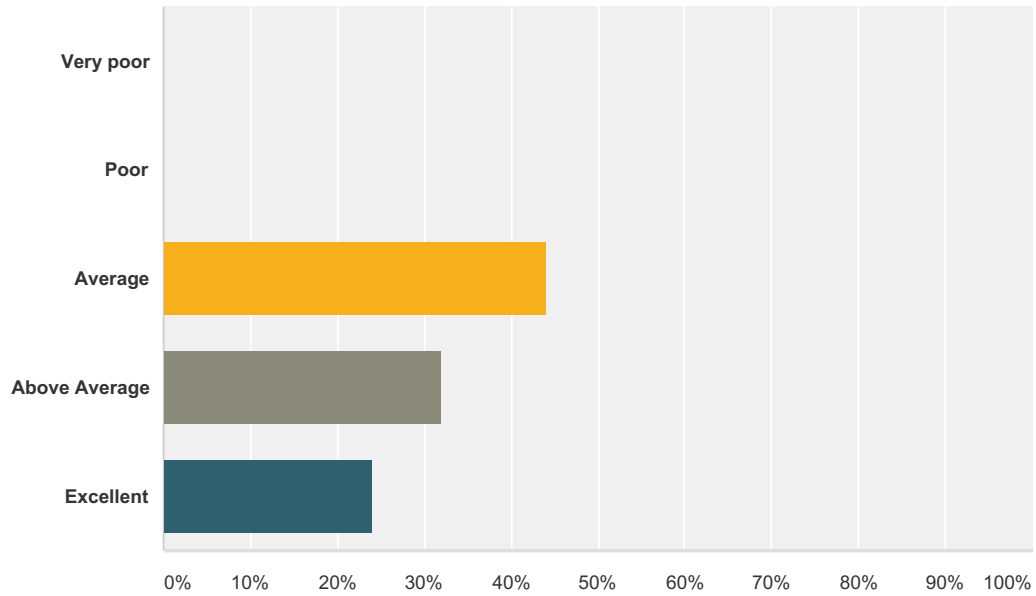

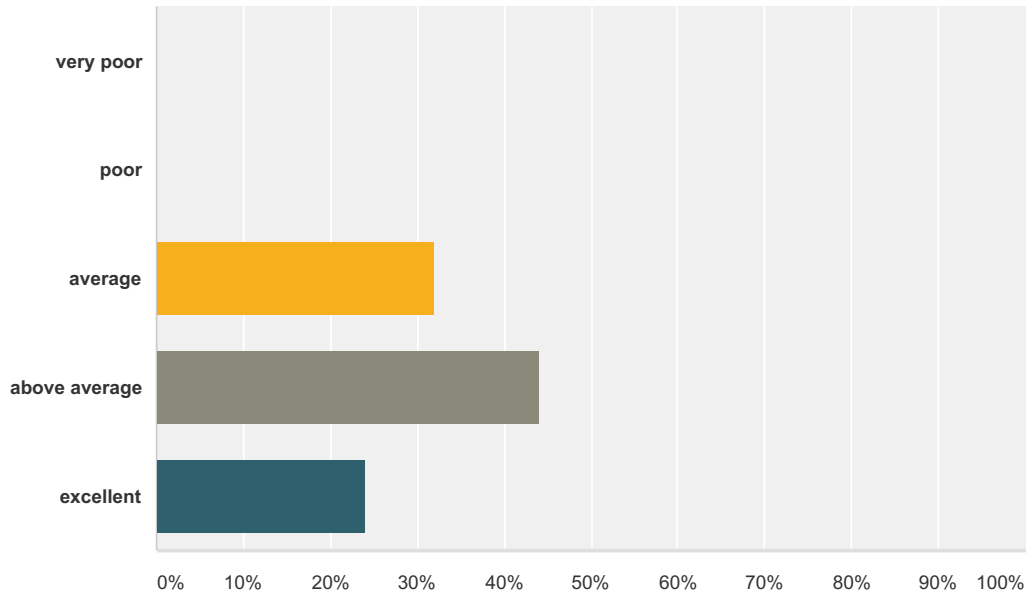

Q7 Compared to other masters degree counseling students that you have hired, CSUF students' ability to think critically and solve problems are:

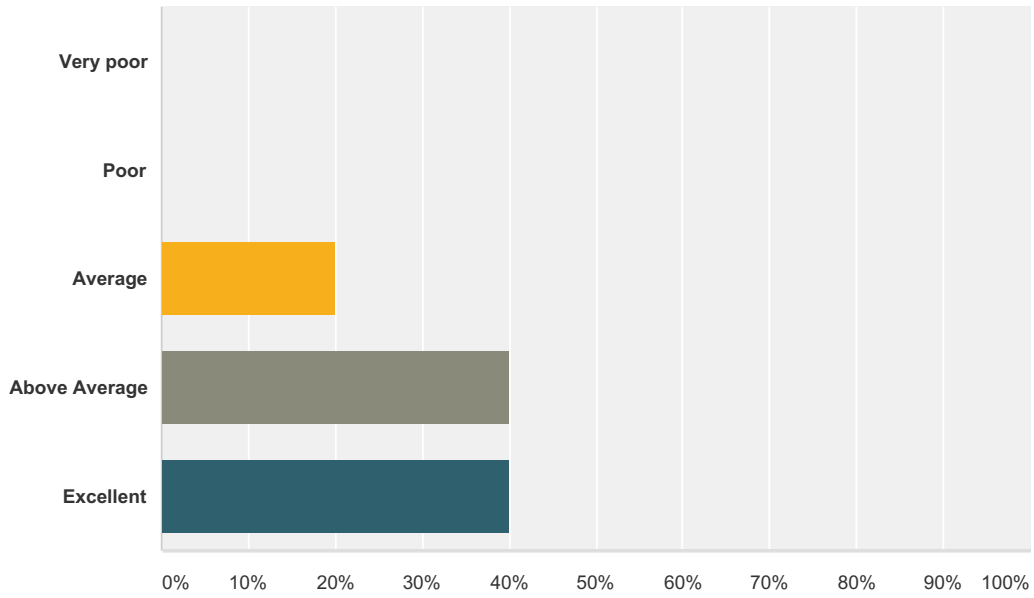

Q8 Your perception of support that students received from CSUF faculty is:

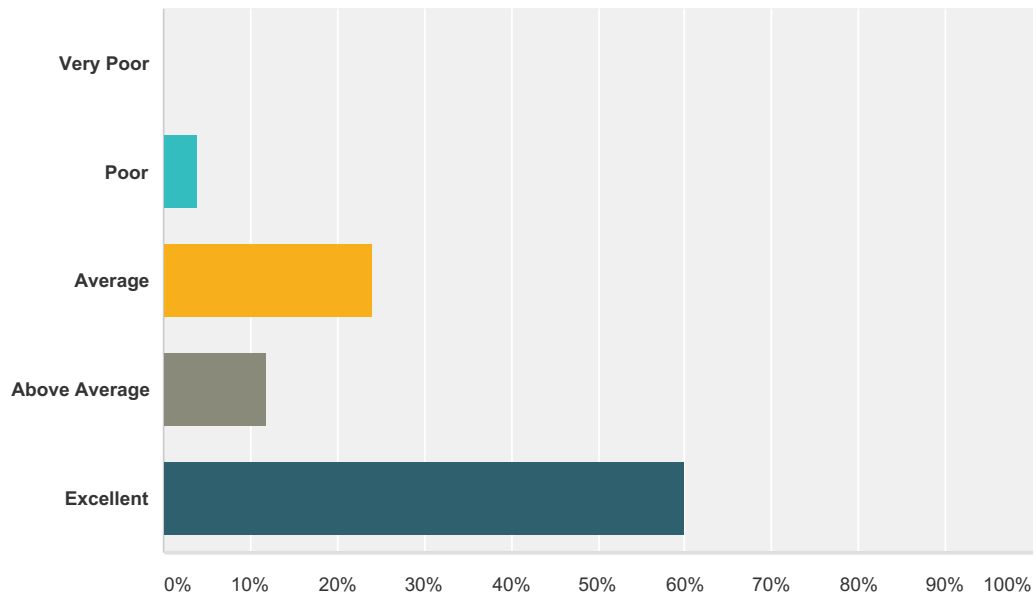
