

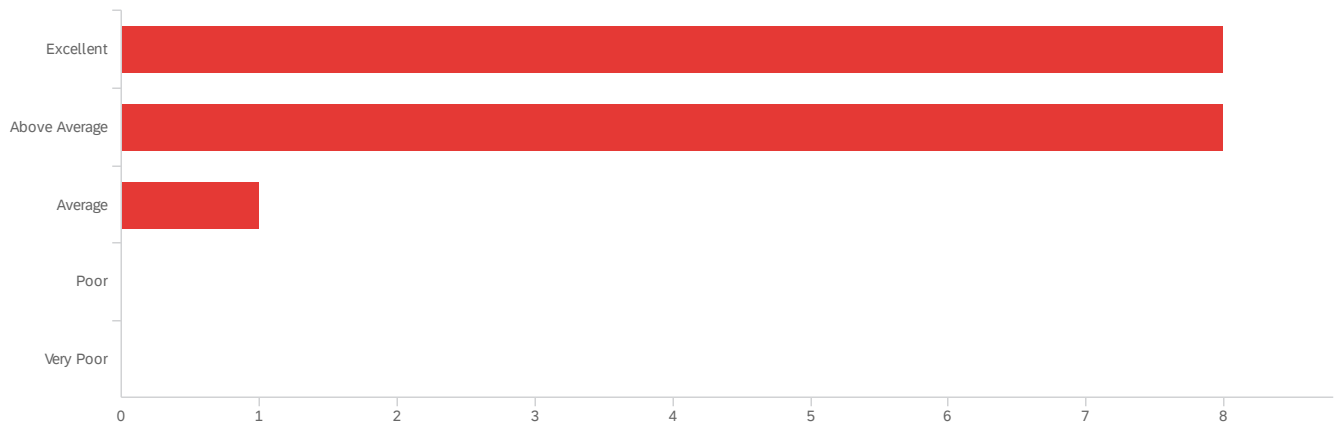

students' overall educational preparation is:

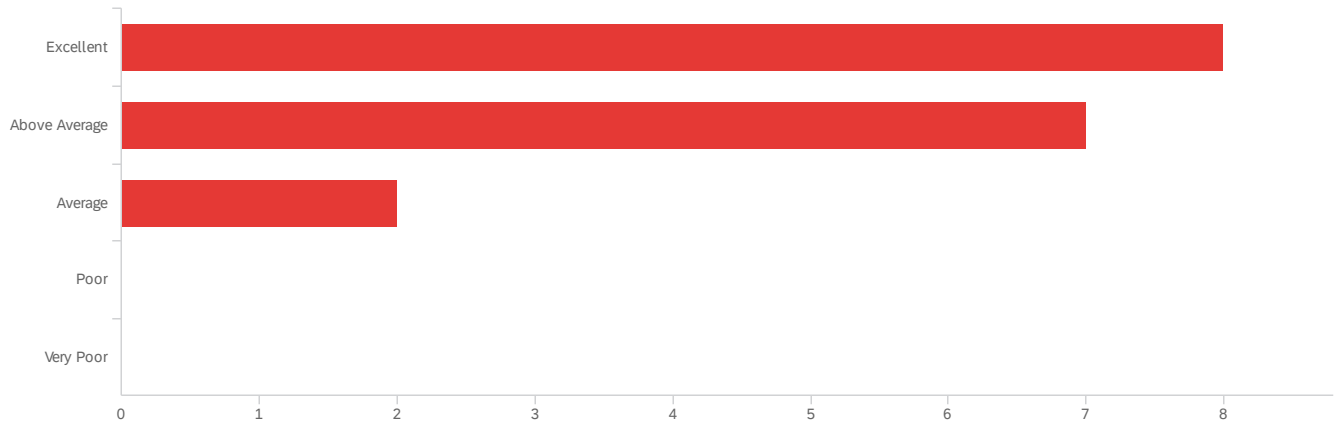

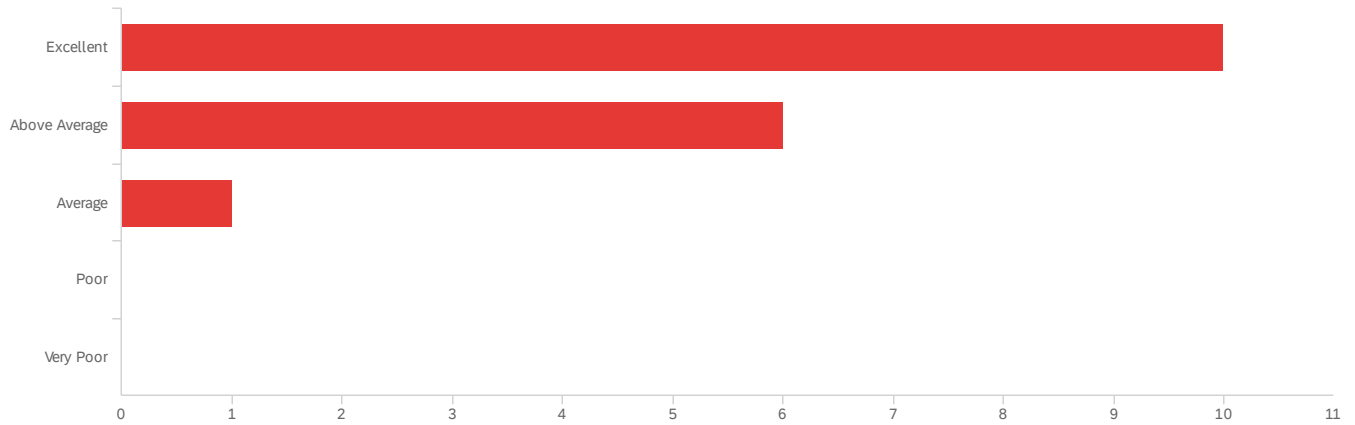

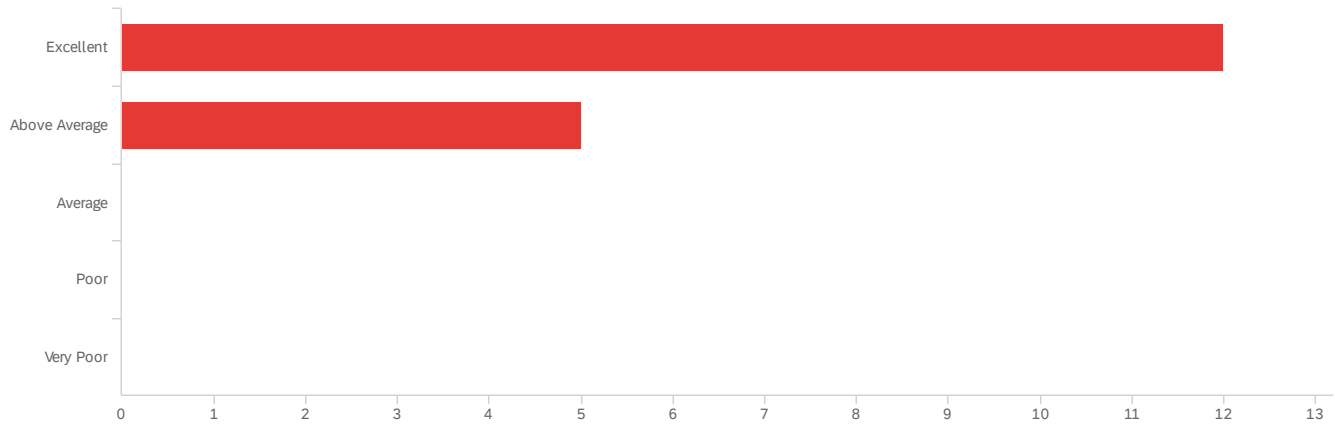

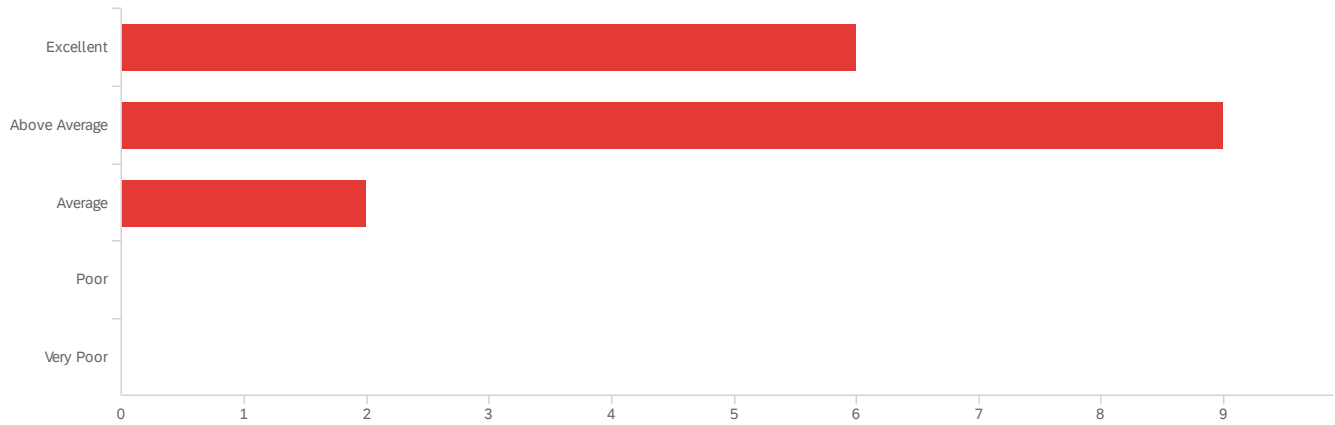

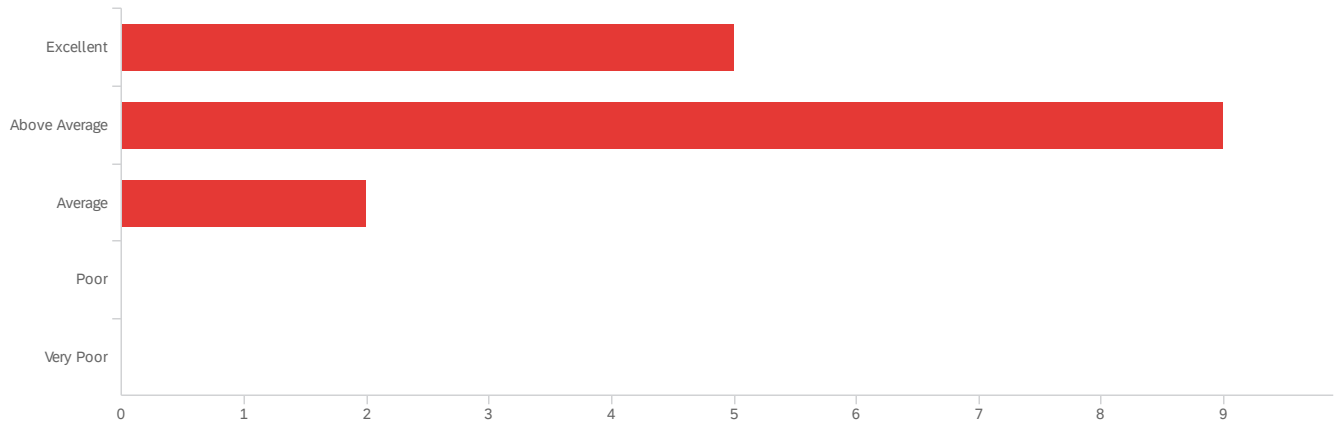

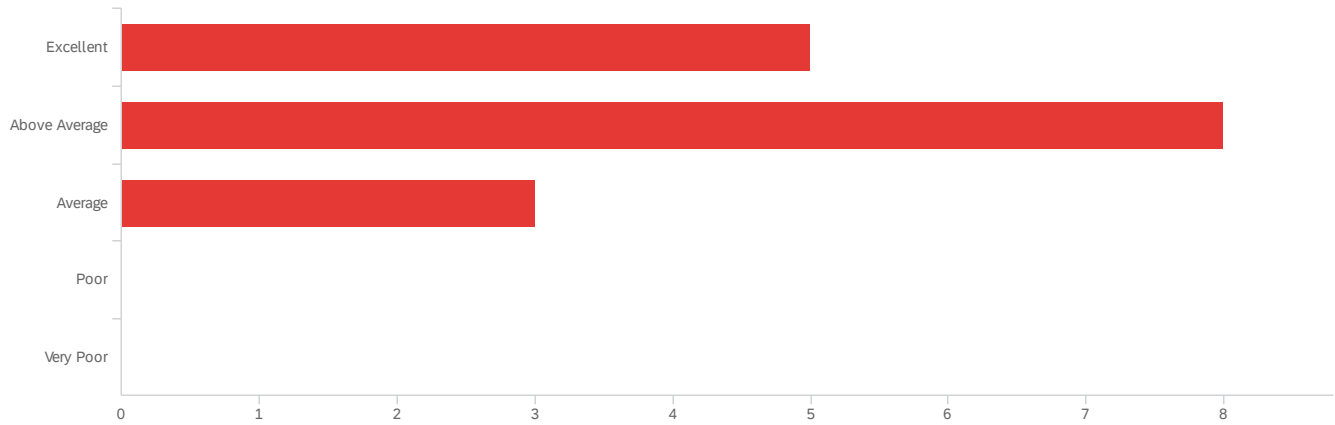

students' ability to think critically and solve problems are:

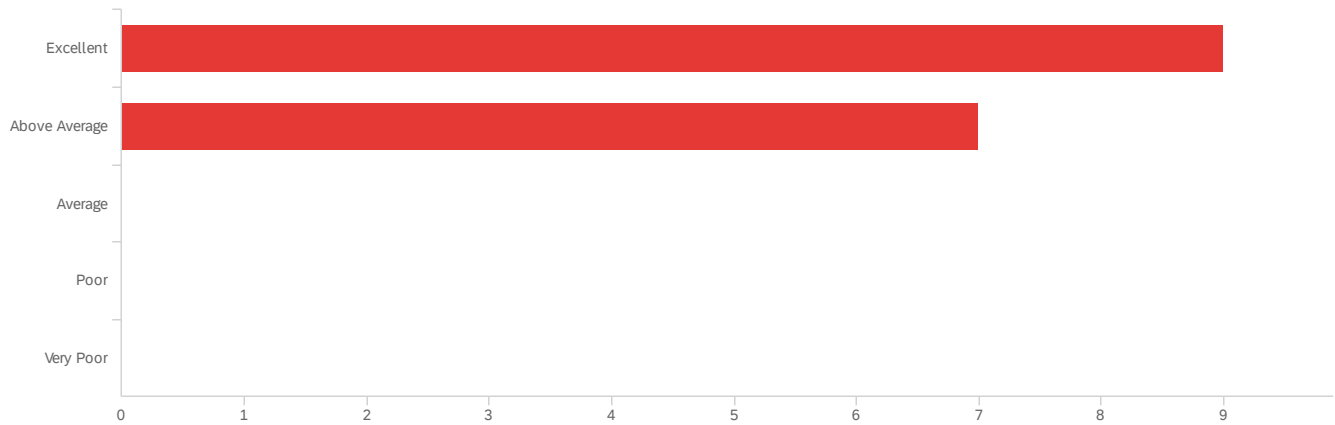

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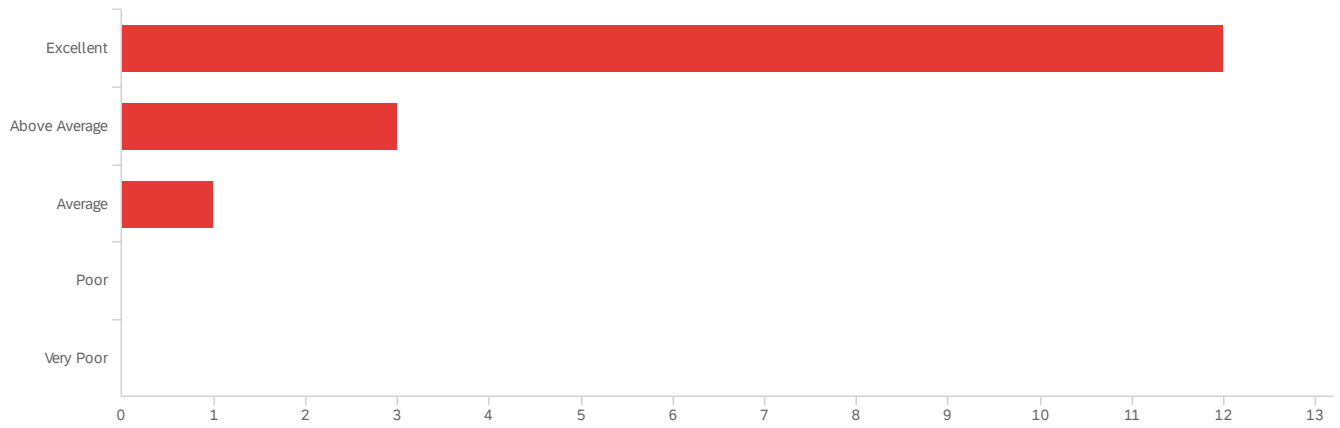
Q8 - Your perception of support that students received from CSUF faculty is:
