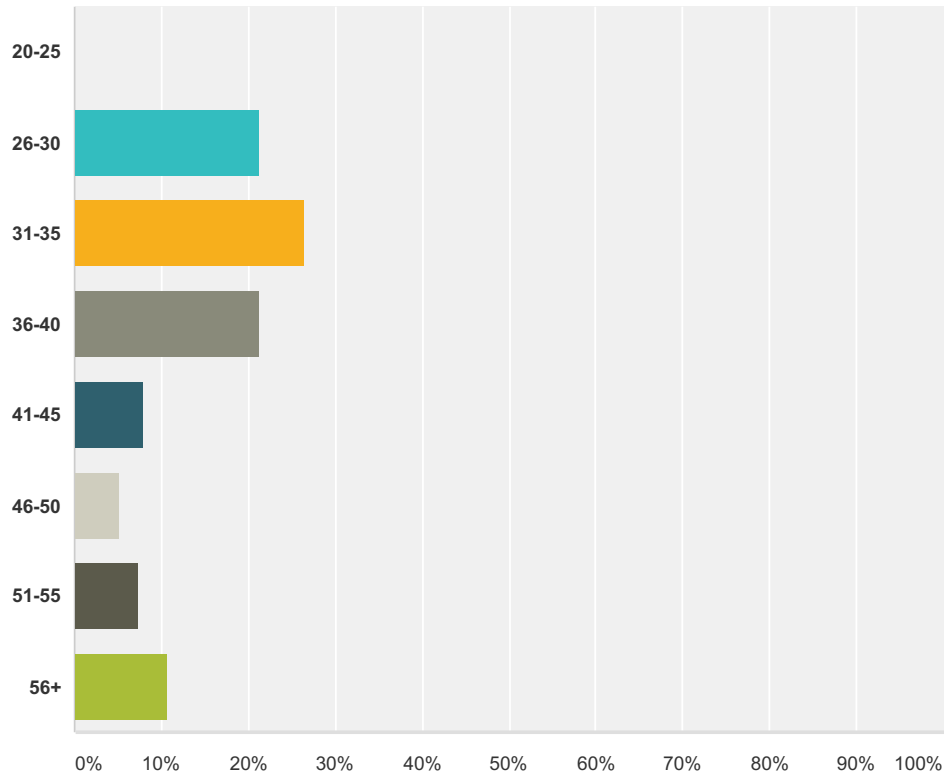

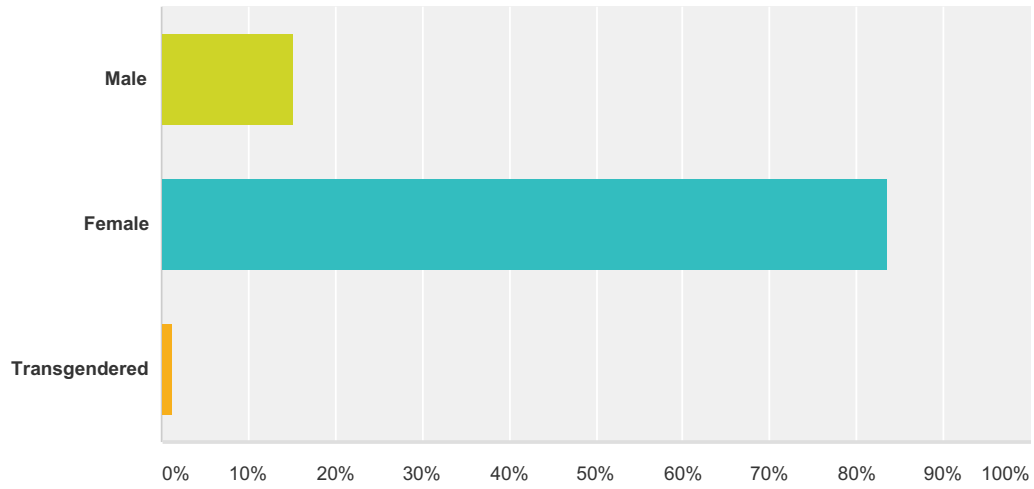

Q2 Gender

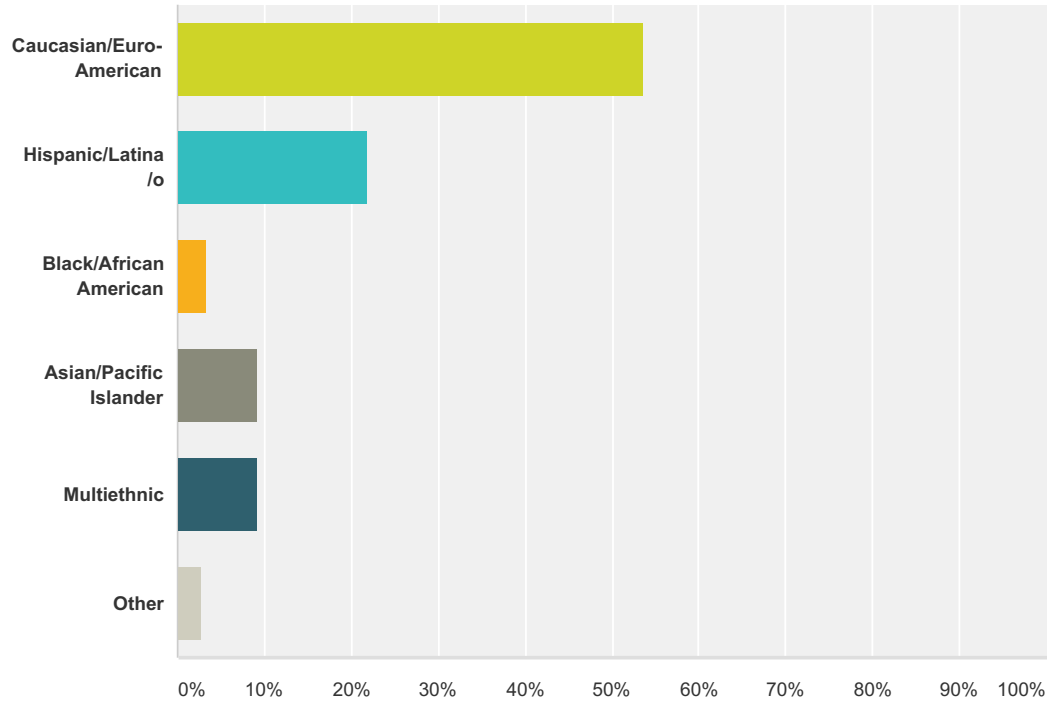

Q3 Ethnicity

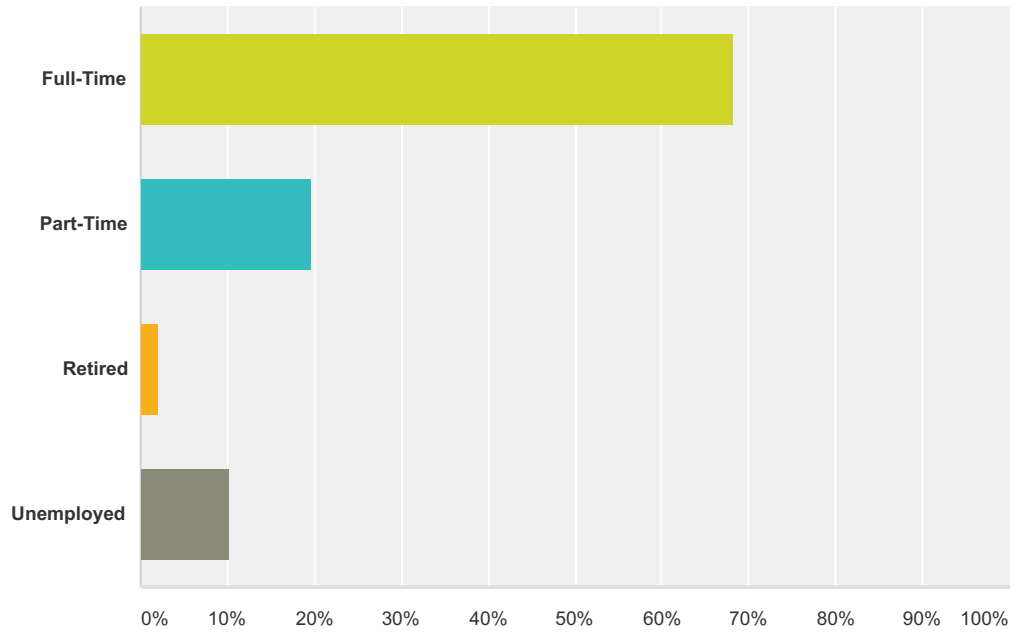

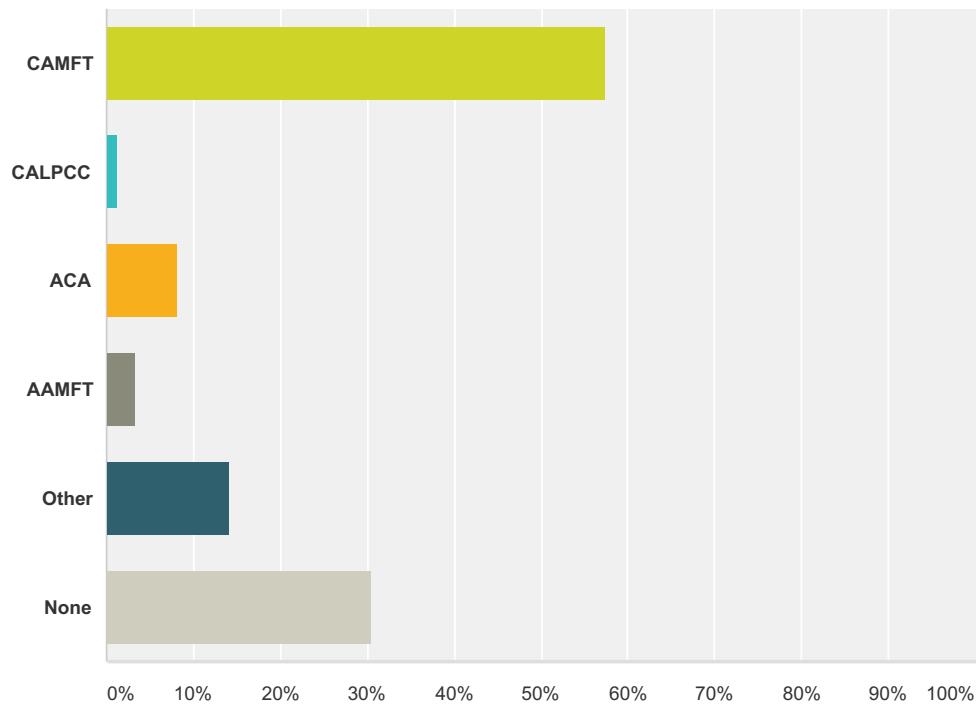

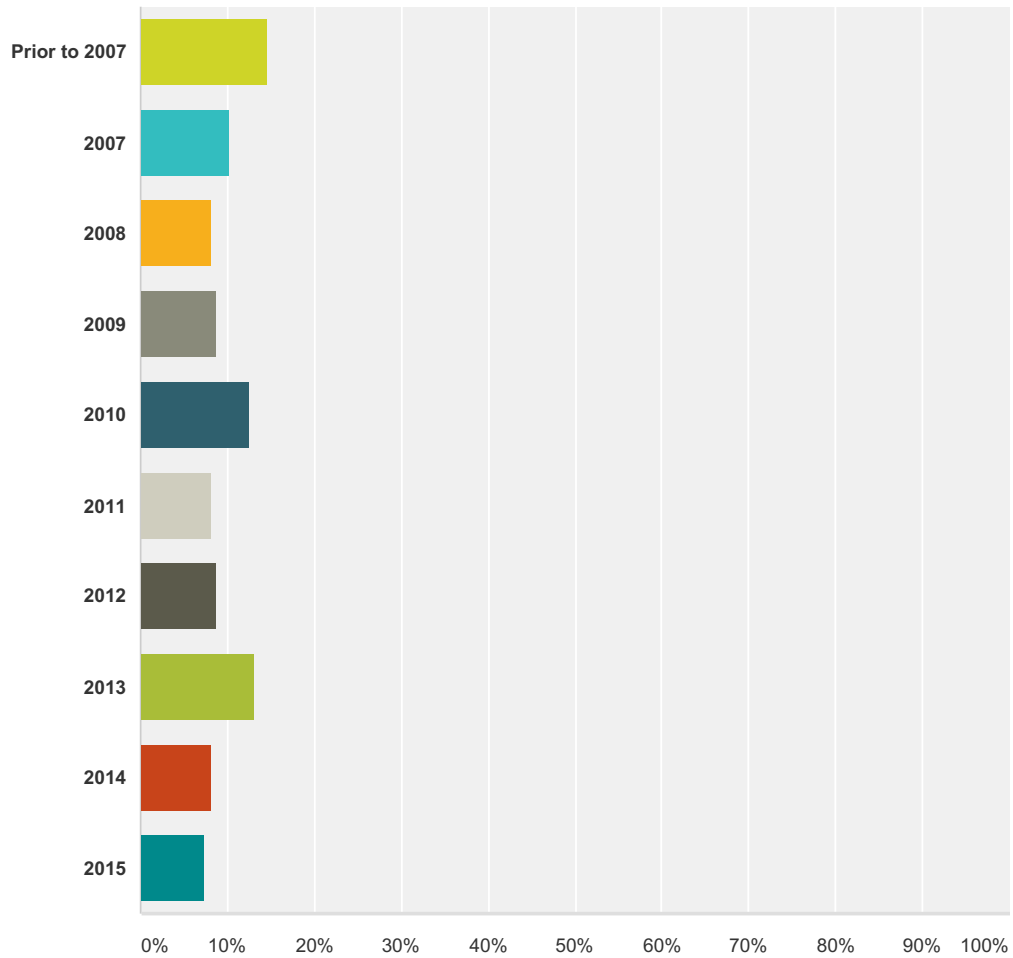

Q9 Date of graduation from CSUF

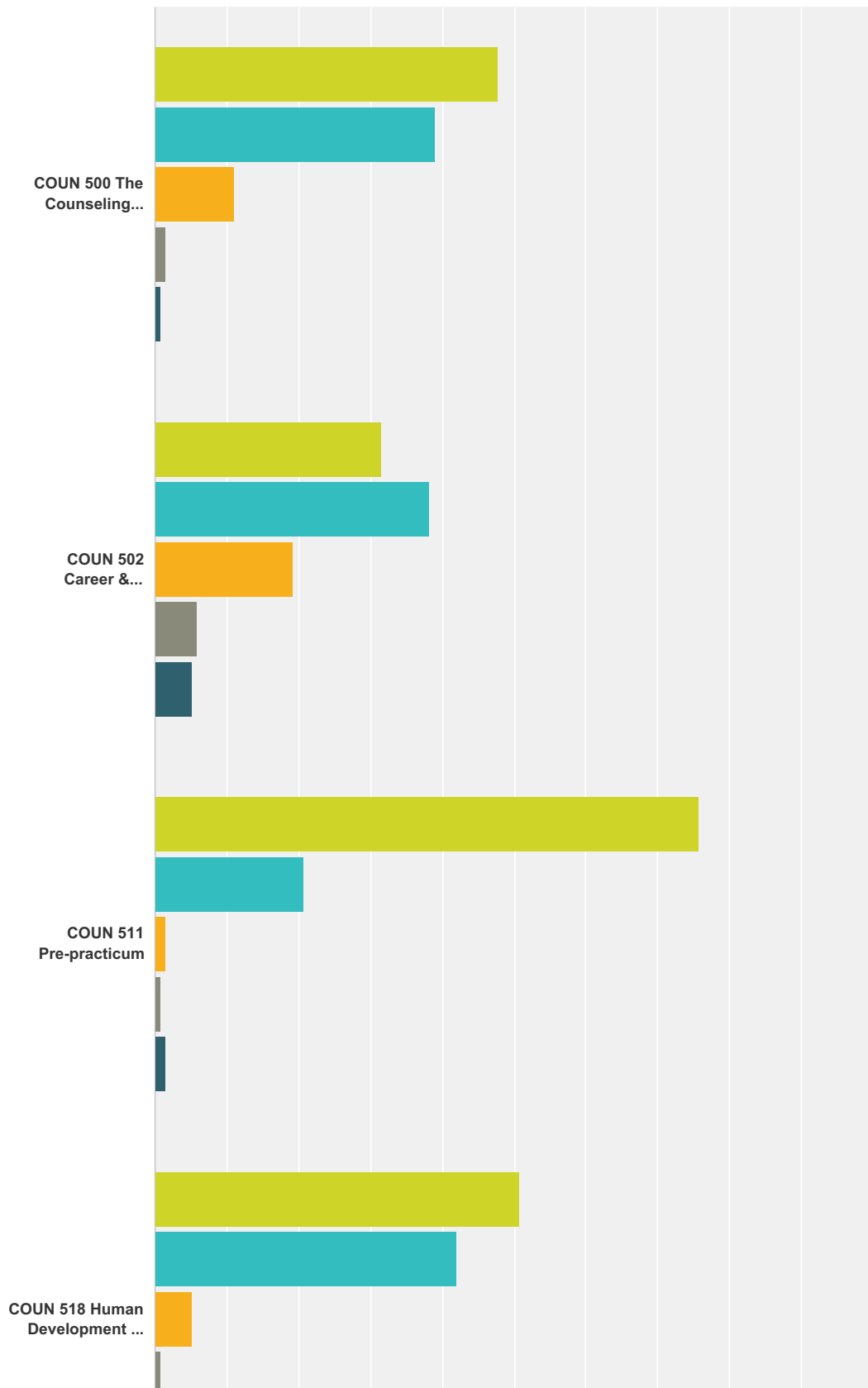

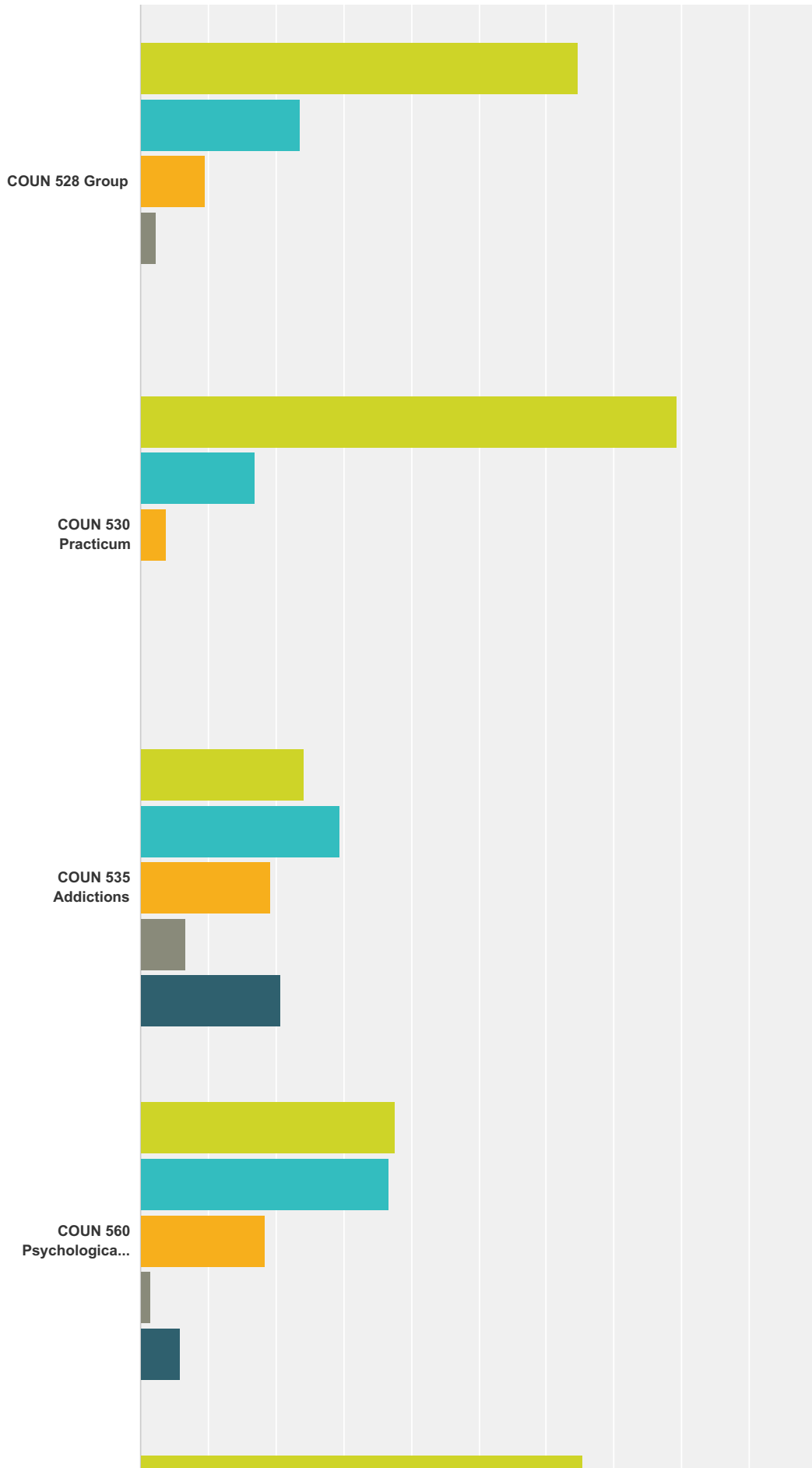
Q10 How would you rate your preparation at CSUF in each of the following areas?

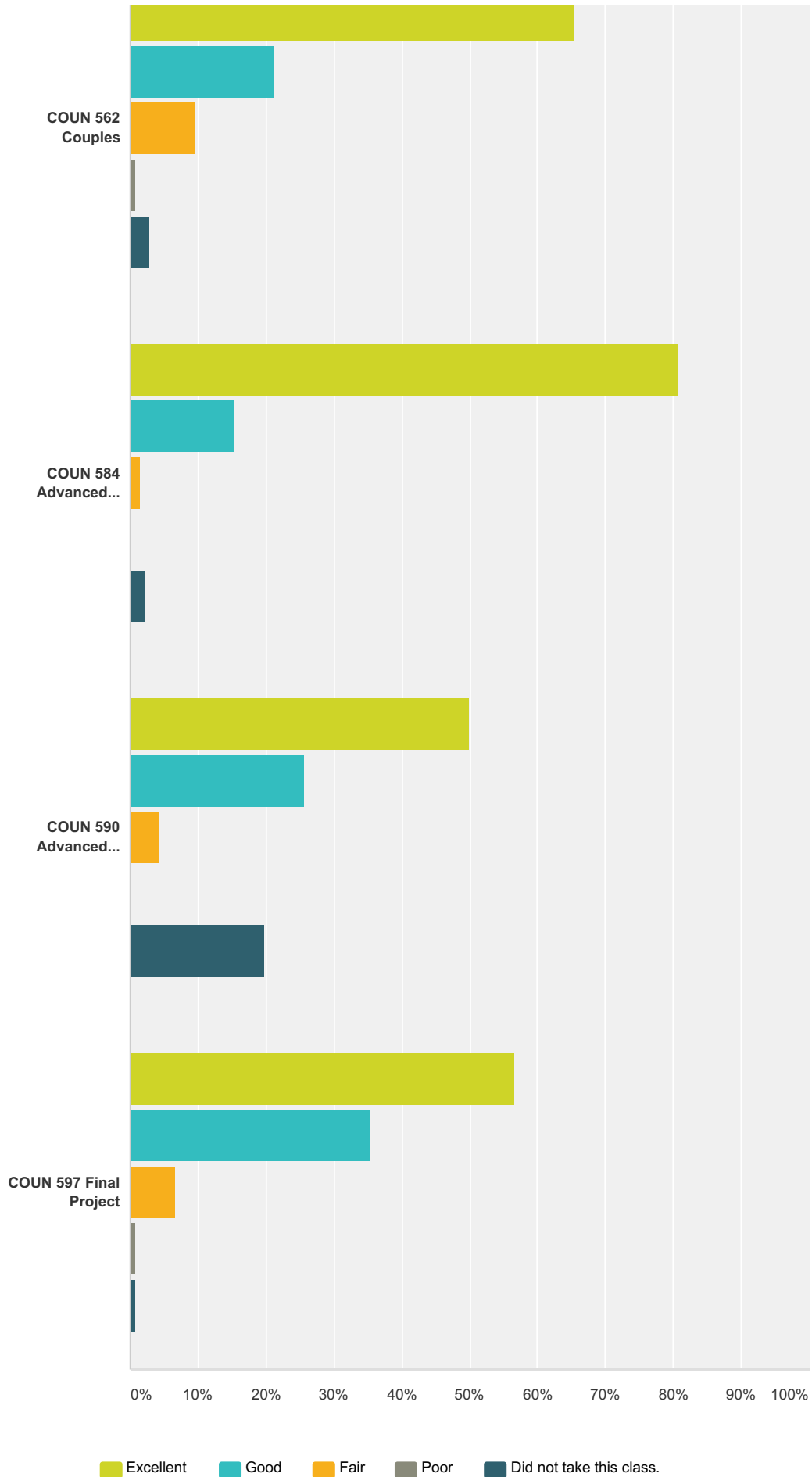

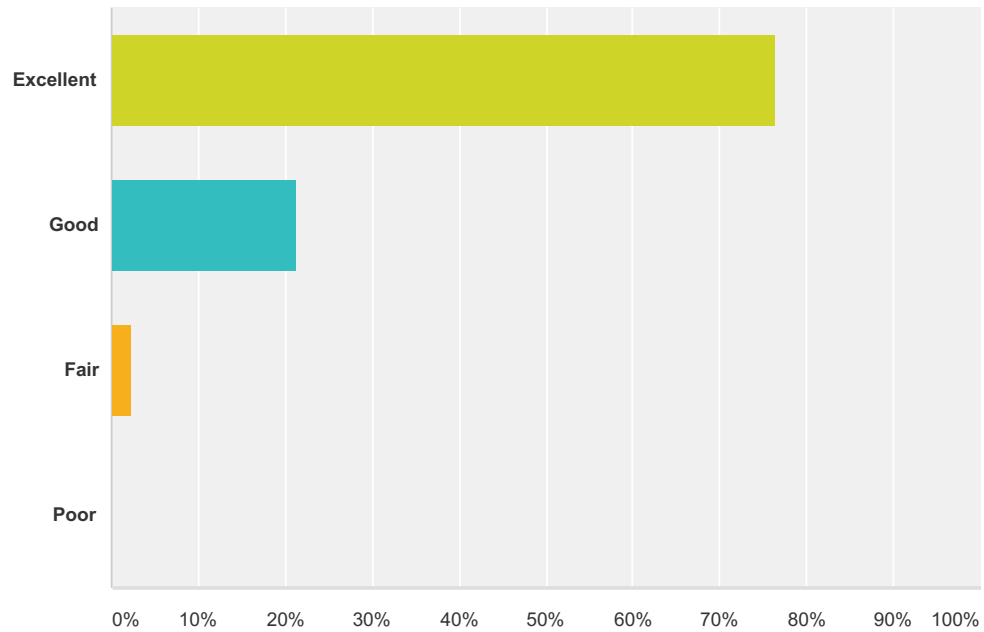

Q11 How would you rate your education and overall experiences in the CSUF Counseling Program?

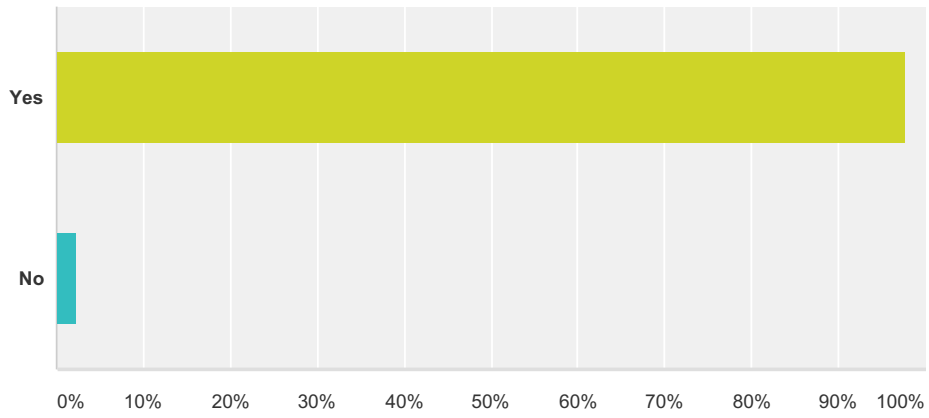

Q12 Would you recommend the CSUF Counseling Program to others?

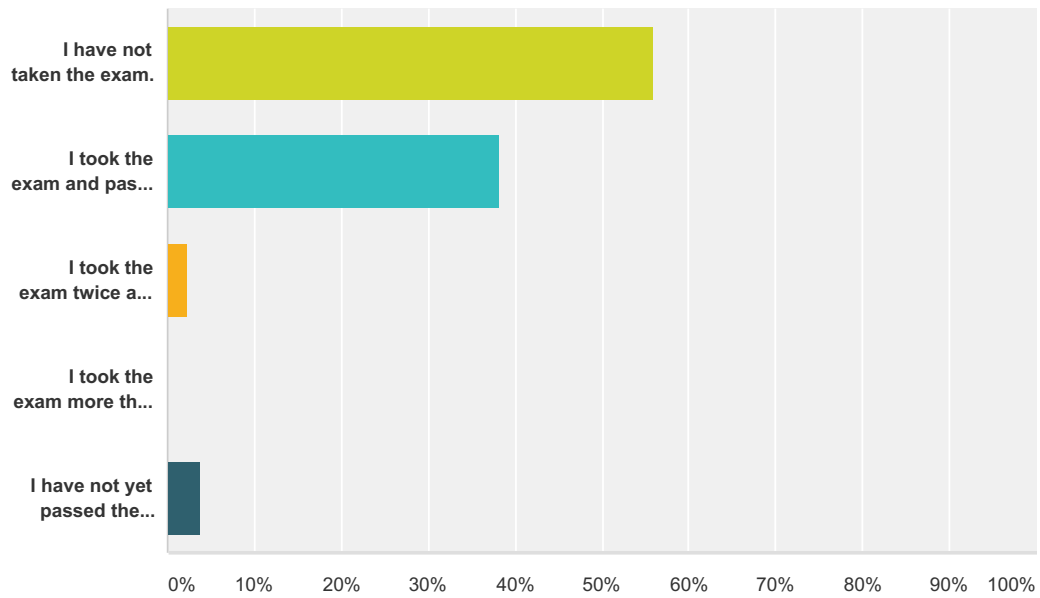

Common responses include:

- Greater focus on clinical documentation such as treatment planning and notes
- Addition of an adolescent counseling course
- Addition of a spirituality course
- Excessive group projects
- Greater focus on neurobiology
- More in-depth theories course
- Improvement of addictions course
- Training/Course on how to build a private practice and marketing skills
- More class times/later class times
- Professor bias against conservative views/certain religions
- More role plays/application of clinical skills in class
- Dissatisfaction with adjunct faculty
- More assistance in finding a job post-graduation
- Better supervision in practicum traineeship
