

Clinical Movement Science

CONCENTRATION

- Concentrations **MUST** officially be declared, by completing a form in the Office of Admissions & Records LH 114
- **A minimum GPA of 3.2 with at least 30 units complete is REQUIRED to apply for this concentration**
- This concentration has limited availability, and can only be declared during the summer PRIOR to Fall semesters
- Students wishing to apply are encouraged to complete volunteer
- **NO exceptions** or course substitutions will be made to the concentration

Required 8 Units (2 Courses):

Three options :

1. **KNES/BIOL 191A** (4 units) Integrated Human Anatomy & Physiology with Lab AND **KNES/BIOL 191B** (4 units) Integrated Human Anatomy & Physiology with Lab (8 units total)

OR

2. **BIOL 310/310L** (3) Human Physiology and (1) Laboratory AND **BIOL 361** (4) Human Anatomy (8 units total)

OR

3. **1 Year of Anatomy/Physiology with Laboratory at a community college** or other accredited institution (8 units total)

Choose 15 Units (5 Courses) from the following (at least 6 units MUST be 400-level):

KNES 205, 351, 354, 364, 365, 373, 374, 375, 377, 378, 414, 451, 453, 454, 455, 461, 463, 470, 495, 499, HESC 401, 411

**This is in addition to the 9 units of Major Pre-Requisites, 9 Units of Foundation Coursework, 18 Units of Disciplinary Core Coursework, 3 Units of Upper Division Writing (ENGL 301), and 51 Units of General Education. A total minimum of 120 units is required for Graduation.

Overview

This concentration is designed for students interested in pursuing graduate school programs and/or careers in ANY clinical based setting such as nursing, athletic training, or physical therapy.

Most courses do NOT meet ALL graduate school prerequisites BUT prepare students to work with patients in a variety of clinical settings.

All concentrations MUST be declared upon completion of 85 units and/or PRIOR to applying for graduation.
