# **ADMISSIONS CRITERIA**

- Fall admission only. Application period opens October 1st
- Bachelor's degree required
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- Applicants must have an educational foundation in liberal arts/social sciences. Students with a bachelor's degree from a CSU or UC Campus meet all prerequisite course requirements
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 units
- Graduate Record Exam (GRE), General Test (Optional)
- Personal statement
- Three letters of recommendation
- Minimum 1 year of paid, volunteer, or internship experience in social services field recommended
- Interview with admissions committee

# LENGTH OF PROGRAM

- Three years; 60 semester units
- Each course meets once per week
- 16-20 hours of fieldwork required per week, during the second and third program years
- Classes meet in the evenings on the Fullerton campus
- Field Placement at affiliated community agencies
