FOUR-YEAR ROADMAP AND CHECKLIST FOR BS IN PUBLIC HEALTH GENERAL STUDIES CONCENTRATION 120 units

The Bachelor of Science in Public Health can be completed in four years, but to do so requires careful planning and preparation. You must average 15 units (five courses) per semester and you must plan ahead so that you will meet all requirements. You can opt to complete courses in the summer or winter session. The below plan is a sample Roadmap. Students may decide or need to switch courses from one semester to another. If you are planning to work, you should adjust your unit load accordingly.

New upper-division transfer students can complete the upper-division requirements in two years provided you have completed at least 60 transferable units, are fully GE certified, and have completed all of the lower-division Public Health courses. See Transfer Student 2-Year Roadmap.

Student Action Plan

Students may create electronic roadmaps in their Titan Planner. In your Student Portal go to "Titan Degree Audit & Planner," then click on the "Plan" tab at the top and "Edit Plan" under the Action Column.

Year 1

- If required, complete all remediation (Math 30A-B, 40, 45, ENGL 99 or 100) by the end of the second semester to avoid Administrative Disqualification.
- Complete GE courses in areas A.1, A.2, A.3, and B.4 with a C- or better.
- Meet with a PUBH academic advisor each semester, located in the KHS Student Success Center in KHS
 193.
- Visit the UH 123B Academic Advisement Center to review GE and graduation requirements.

Year 2

- *Only a 1-unit lab for GE B.3 is required, student decides which lab to complete, can be completed in the same semester as B.1 or B.2.
- Must complete 9 units of Upper Division GEs, one from each of the following sections: B.5, C.4, and D.4.
- One course from GE Area C.4 or D.4 must double count with Cultural Diversity, GE Area Z (indicated by an asterisk* on the Academic Advising Center's Website
 - http://www.fullerton.edu/undergraduate/general_education/courses-after-2018.php).
- Additional information regarding Concentrations, including declaring one, is given in HESC 320.
- All PUBH major courses must be completed with a C- or better.

Year 3

- Apply for graduation, FILE GRAD CHECK, through your student center once you have earned 85 units and are one year from graduation.
- Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA in all GPAs on Titan Degree Audit.
- HESC 349 is a prerequisite for HESC 401.
- HESC 401 is a pre- or co-requisite for HESC 475.

Year 4

- HESC 495: Internship in HESC should be taken in your Senior Year (usually your last semester).
- Review TDA to ensure all requirements have been met and if any questions arise, meet with PUBH major advisor regarding major coursework.
- Pay graduation fees at least one semester prior to graduating.
- Attend a Mandatory In-Person Grad Check Workshop to have your Graduation Check approved.
- This degree requires a cumulative minimum of 120 units.
